City Wide Celebration: Festival of Learning

SANTA FE, NEW MEXICO – Santa Fe Mentoring and Tutoring Collaborative (SFMT) welcomes the community in celebrating the accomplishments and growth of Santa Fe's youth from 2:00 – 6:00 PM, Sunday May 5, 2019, at the Santa Fe Convention Center. Each day mentors and tutors grow through their relationships with youth while helping them find their passions and potential. Through interactive exhibits, and performances parents and children will learn about these profound connections. Youth will represent a variety of organizations such as INSPIRE Santa Fe, Big Brothers Big Sisters, Communities in Schools of New Mexico, Monte del Sol Charter School, STEM Scaffold Santa Fe and dozens more. Wise Fool New Mexico and Aspen Ballet's Flamenco, will also join in celebration.

Santa Fe Mayor Alan Webber recognizes the direct, measurable impact mentors and tutors have on our social and economic ecosystem. The day of the festival, the Mayor will present his vision of a city where every youth will have an opportunity to participate in a caring, respectful and learning relationship with an adult volunteer.

"There tends to be a notion that education looks like one thing, done one way, in one place, for everybody. What's so wonderful about the Festival of Learning is that it breaks away from this one-size-fits-all model and demonstrates that there are many ways to both teach and learn. That the people who are the volunteers learn as much as the young people. By the end of the day, everyone has gained from this experience." Mayor Webber says.

SFMT's partners have identified that over 500 youth in Santa Fe are currently in need of a mentor and/or tutor. Todd Lopez, INSPIRE Santa Fe, acknowledges this growing need, "As a society, too often we leave the opportunity for these relationships to chance." Throughout the festival, community members are encouraged to meet with organizations so they can become mentors and/or tutors. The Santa Fe Mentoring and Tutoring Collaborative hopes that through this celebration more youth will be connected to caring adults.
